

The St. Tammany Master Gardener Association gives the scholarship. It is given to encourage the study of Agriculture, Horticulture or related fields at the collegiate or graduate level of study.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be currently enrolled and in good standing at a Louisiana University, Community College, Vocational or Technical Institution.
- Applicants must be a graduate of a public or private St. Tammany Parish High School. Attach official high school transcript or copy of high school diploma.
- Applicants must be pursuing a degree in Horticulture, Agricultural or a related field.
- Applicants must be considered a full time student and have completed 24 semester hours or the equivalent.
- Applicants must provide an official college transcript.
- Applicants must have a GPA of 2.5 or above.
- Applicants must complete an essay of 300 words as stated in the application.
- Application deadline is February 28.

### Terms of STMGA Scholarship:

- The value of the scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,500. Scholarship money will be paid directly to the University, Community College, Vocational or Technical Institution.
- The number of scholarships awarded will be based on applicants meeting STMGA criteria and money available.
- The STMGA Scholarship is a financial award granted without regard to race, religion, sex, age, or disability.
- The decision of the STMGA Scholarship Committee is final.
- The STMGA Scholarship Committee reserves the right to not award the scholarship if applicants fail to meet the above criteria.
- Students may reapply annually.
